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great concern to many citizens of Nebraska because they do not trust the Legislature and this opens the door to more tax on services, more categories, and the people do not trust our voracious appetite...

SPEAKER BAACK: Time.

SENATOR PIRSCH: ...for more revenue.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Pirsch. Senator Hefner, you're next.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, I rise to do something but I don't know exactly what. Mr. Speaker, could I have a clarification of what we're on right now?

SPEAKER BAACK: I hope so, Elroy. No, we have divided the Schellpeper amendment.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay.

SPEAKER BAACK: And right now we are discussing all of the Schellpeper amendment except for the breeding livestock exemption.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay.

SPEAKER BAACK: I think that's correct. Is that correct, Mr. Clerk? That is what we are discussing.

SENATOR HEFNER: We're taking out the exemption of breeding livestock from taxation. Okay, thank you very much.

SPEAKER BAACK: That part of the amendment is out. We're discussing the amendment in two parts and the part of the amendment is all of the other amendment that deals with all the other issues in there and then after we deal with this, then we will deal with the livestock exemption.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay, thank you, Mr. Speaker. Right now we're debating the Schellpeper amendment with the breeding livestock, exempting breeding livestock from taxation. We're leaving that out. Okay. Okay, I think this is a fair amendment. I have never been a supporter of sales tax on services, but I believe we need to get started on that. As we've done research, we find
