SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Mr. President, thank you, Senator Hartnett, for the rest of your time. Senator Ashford, once this amendment, you've proposed it, I've not spoke today, but there's some things that I guess bother me with the amendment. One, I haven't been able to read it yet, but, two, when you...when we took the vote on the exclusion of the farm equipment and business equipment, was that new, only equipment, or was that new and used equipment?

SENATOR ASHFORD: I believe it's new and used, Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay, the figures then you gave us was approximated a \$40 million hit. Now the stuff that I've got throughout, some of our, the 3-R meetings and some of the other information that I've gotten from the Department of Revenue says that new and used figure is \$78 million. And so...

SENATOR ASHFORD: It's new, Senator Kristensen, I apologize.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay, so it's new equipment only and not used equipment?

SENATOR ASHFORD: That's correct.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay, I just need...could you show me where that's at in the amendment because I...

SENATOR ASHFORD: Well, Senator Kristensen, why don't we talk about it? Wait till you get done with your speech and then I'll show you where it is.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay, because I...there are just some of those spots, because it makes a big difference on the amount of replacement revenue.

SENATOR ASHFORD: If you want to come up and ask me, I'll show you where it is.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay, that's very good. I'll yield my time back. Thank you.
