But I want to say also, no one that I talked to, with the exception of a few of my colleagues and a few people outside of this...of the body, want to tax personal property. It is going to be imposed upon us whether we like it or not, we've been told that. Ladies and gentlemen, I don't like it, and to the extent that I can do so, I will oppose it if it takes the rest of the session. Thank you.

(Applause.)

SPEAKER BAACK: I would ask you not to do that, or we will have you removed from the Chamber. We do not allow demonstrations in the Chamber.
