PRESIDENT MOUL: One minute.

SENATOR MOORE: ...would be willing to do that and whatever my one vote does with that, I would encourage the other members of the body to think about that. I think it would be much more prudent to do it right and do it all in one bill instead of linking 1063 to another bill and allowing 1063 to advance tonight without it cash flowing, we already know what the agreement is, let's do it all at once. But I understand Senator Landis's point.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Moore. Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President and members of the body, only to reiterate what's already been said, drafting error yesterday in 3371 that will be corrected by this particular amendment. The amendment yesterday applied only to nitrogen fertilizer. That was not the intent of the effort. This puts the correct language in 1063, so I'd encourage your consideration of the reconsideration motion and then the substitution of the proposed amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Senator Beutler. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I appreciate Senator Coordsen's remarks because they were directed toward the motion for reconsideration.
