

SENATOR HARTNETT: I call the question.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Are there sufficient seconds? There are. We will now vote on the motion to cease debate. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to cease debate? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay to cease debate, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have ceased debate and I will call on Senator Lindsay for closing, or Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, Senator Lindsay would like to have his name withdrawn from the amendment, that's the amendment we're going to be offering here in a moment. The motion right now is the procedural motion of reconsidering the adoption of this amendment. It is a procedural attempt at this time to have before us again the Lindsay amendment so we can consider amendments to an alternate way of accomplishing what we sought to accomplish yesterday. I would urge your support of the amendment, of the motion to reconsider.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Withem. We'll now vote on the motion to reconsider. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 1 nay, Madam President, on the motion to reconsider adoption of Senator Lindsay and Lamb's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion is adopted.

CLERK: Madam President...

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Lindsay, are there any comments, opening comments you want to make before we go to the amendment?

SENATOR LINDSAY: Yeah, to open I would simply ask the body to by unanimous consent allow me to withdraw my name as sponsor and insert Loran Schmit's name as sponsor if there is...never mind, I won't do that. (laughter) I would simply move the amendment once it gets amended by the Landis-Lamb amendment and even though it won't then become the Landis-Lamb amendment, I'd still move that it would be amended, I mean moved after that.
