PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Dierks. We will now vote on the Dierks amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: I'd like to ask for a call of the house, please. I suspect we ought to have a roll call vote too. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have a request for a call of the house. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chambers and record their presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. Would the senators please check in. The house is under call. Looking for Senators Ashford, Baack, Bernard-Stevens, Senator Lynch, Senator Morrissey, Senator Conway, Senator Rasmussen, Senator Robinson, Senator Elmer, Senator Warner, Senator Wesely, Senator Labeledz. Senator Dierks, we are just waiting for Senator Baack, would you like to proceed with roll call? Proceed with roll call vote on the Dierks amendment to the committee amendments.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote. See pages 1373-74 of the Legislative Journal.) 18 ayes, 23 nays, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment fails. I will raise the call. Before we proceed I would like to call the senators' attention to the south balcony.
