PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Bernard-Stevens, Senator Lynch, Senator Moore, Senator Nelson, would you please check in. Senator Beyer, Senator Byars, Senator Conway, Senator Robak. Senator Schmit, Senator Schrock, and Senator Hartnett, would you please check in.

CLERK: Senator Conway voting yes. Senator Hartnett voting yes. Senator Horgan voting yes. Senator Beyer voting yes.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Please record, Mr. Clerk.
