And, again, looking at it being a state agency that would do some of the compiling of facts and the things that we would like to have I think, and information that would be needed, systems that could be put in place for gathering data will be very helpful and we would find, I think, some areas and some things that we could do that would be very positive in looking at unintended pregnancies and the prevention of those. I agree with probably some of the individuals on the floor that have talked about the fact that the debate is good. I'd like to think that after spending this many hours on a subject that we will come up with something that is positive, something that we can agree on, something that will be helpful and not harmful, and that we have taken an issue that is very difficult and that we have addressed it, I believe, in a manner that we can say to constituents at home it was a good debate and that we did do something positive, and that something did come out of spending eight hours on this floor. And maybe the remark that I had made earlier, if we all spent our time looking at something we could work together on instead of maybe just one piece of legislation would help, and that could very well happen before this evening is over. So with those thoughts in mind, I would urge you to seriously look at this amendment, what it could do, and to support the amendment, and we could come up with something that would help just an awful lot of people in the State of Nebraska. SENATOR WARNER: No, ma'am, we have an amendment pending.

SENATOR WARNER: Requires, under the rules, eight hours.

SENATOR ROBAK: And how many hours do we have left?

SENATOR WARNER: I don't know what time we started.

SENATOR ROBAK: You don't know.

SENATOR WARNER: Probably until about nine, I would guess, or thereabout.
