SENATOR WARNER: One minute.

SENATOR CROSBY: ...I have talked...I have talked about this before when we talk about abortion. This is an opportunity for all of us to get together and share these ideas and see if we cannot learn from each other. The first time I talked about abortion a couple, three years ago probably, I said we do not listen to each other, and that is the beginning and the end of the problem. Because unless we listen to each other and try to understand each other, we will never...we can form all the task forces you want in the world, but we will never come to any conclusions. So I think that is really important that we listen to each other with understanding, compassion for each other. We are all people. We are all in this together, and no matter how you feel about the subject of abortion, the family problems all must be brought together in any kind of study or any kind of task force that you have. SENATOR WARNER: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature. There is good reason to initiate a study rather along the lines that the commission language reads in this amendment. Once a woman of any age becomes pregnant, all of the options at that point carry some health risk, and that health risk can be significant. By the way, I thought Senator Crosby's
