SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Schmit. Any other discussion on the committee amendments on LB 1240? Seeing none, Senator Hall, would you like to close on the committee amendments.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. Speaker, I would just urge adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the closing on the committee amendments. We will now vote on the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the committee amendments to LB 1240. Have you all voted? We are voting on the committee amendments to LB 1240. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: The committee amendments are adopted. We will now go to LB 1240. Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, I think the committee amendments that we just adopted becomes LB 1240, it actually creates three types of Enterprise Zones, one with the normal Enterprise Zone where you...with three conditions, unemployment, loss of people, and over...kind of below a tax levy. That's one. The other one is where they have lost 300 jobs within the last year. And the third one is if they qualify under a...the federal Impact Zone. And, with that, I would simply, if there's no questions, simply ask for advancement of this bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. Further discussion. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Question of Senator Hartnett.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hartnett, would you respond, please.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I'm looking for some sort of fiscal impact on this bill, and it doesn't seem to jump out at me. What do you estimate this bill is going to cost in revenue?
