The other points that we've discussed this evening are still in here. There's I think some excellent, good policy decisions that we've made, that we've outlined before. I would urge the adoption of this amendment. Then the next amendment is the amendment where I think if people have policy objections to administrative license revocation, that's when you should vote no, if you believe in that you should vote yes. But at least at this point we can have an up or down vote on the ALR. But regardless of the outcome of that amendment, you still have a good piece of legislation, one that has basically been a study over ten years that we've done to correct some of the things that we need to do. Yes, there are some penalty changes. Yes, there is applying drunk driving to other places other than just on the streets and alleys. But I do think that it's good legislation, I'd urge the adoption of this amendment, then have the policy discussion on ALR with the next amendment. I would urge the adoption of this amendment.
