ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, the first confirmation report is from the Business and Labor Committee. It is found on page 1984 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body, it's a pleasure for me this morning to recommend to the body of the Legislature, for confirmation, three appointments to the State Boiler Safety Advisory Board. I think it is a rare occurrence when we have three people who are so well qualified to serve in any position of all of the many boards and commissions that we have. I'd recommend for your confirmation Mr. John Campbell. John has been chief mechanical inspector for the City of Omaha for the last 14 years. Mr. Tom Hix is with Omaha Public Power. He supervises, maintains and modifies the operations of five boiler turbine generator units in the North Omaha Station. Mr. Dick Gregg is a boiler maker in addition to being a Sarpy County Commissioner. He has been on the management side as well as the physical side of boiler operations. I would recommend these three very highly to you this morning. Thank you, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Does anyone wish to speak to this confirmation report? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to adopt the confirmation report. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
