Then on Tuesday we will convene at 9:00 a.m., and I assume that we will continue on if we're able to on Monday to start Select File debate, then on Tuesday we will continue...or General File debate, I mean, we will continue with the General File debate on Tuesday and possibly even some Select File debate on Tuesday on the issues that are before us. Wednesday we will again convene at nine and at that point we will also be considering Select File...we will be considering Select File debate. I would note that we have to have any bills that we decide to pass on to Final Reading will have to be returned to us before we adjourn that day so that they are correctly engrossed. And then Thursday would be the layover day that's constitutionally provided for that these bills have to lay over and then on Friday we would meet...Thursday, we would check in at 9:00 a.m., but then it would simply be a layover day. Friday we would convene at 9:00 a.m. for Final Reading and then the sine die adjournment at that point. That is the schedule that I have set up so far. Senator Lamb, did you wish to be recognized?
