SENATOR WARNER: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President and members. Senator Schrock, would you respond to a question.

SENATOR WARNER: Will Senator Schrock yield.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Schrock, are Virgil's daughters collecting tax on those dollar pony rides? Never mind, I would urge adoption of the resolution.

SENATOR WARNER: Seeing no further lights, Senator Cudaback, do you wish to close? Senator Cudaback waives closing. Those in favor of LR 3 vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of LR 3.

SENATOR WARNER: The motion is carried. The resolution is adopted. Before we go to Select File, the Legislature has a guest under the south balcony, Mr. Trevor Hergenreder of Gering, who also is the grandson of Senator Hillman. CLERK: Mr. President, LB 7, I have Enrollment and Review amendments pending.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Will.
