SENATOR MOORE: Cough syrup in my mouth, okay.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay, now, Senator Moore, LB 21 deals with the Youth Academy, and I had stepped out yesterday when this came up, so I didn't get an opportunity to ask this question, but I noticed that on the previous...on the back sheet of our agenda, the 30,000 wasn't mentioned. Now you handed the sheet out this morning, a white sheet, where it was on there. Could you expound a little bit more on that 30,000, where does that go, and what happens to it?

SENATOR MOORE: Well...

SENATOR HEFNER: I would like to (interruption).

SENATOR MOORE: It is my understanding the reason that it was not on the original agenda, that was not part of the Appropriations Committee bill package, did not appear that way. Now that the bill appears to be destined for passage, you will notice that what we have this morning, there is a \$30,000 reduction, Legislative Council. That will be a reduction in the base of the Legislative Council, and a like amount as the bill indicates. So it is not like if you pass this bill, the money goes to someplace else in Research in the Legislative Council. If you pass this bill, there will be...the next biennium when we build our budget, the Legislative Council's budget will start out 30,000 less than it is this year.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay, thank you for that answer, and with that answer will certainly ease my mind because I was concerned that it would stay in the Legislature's Council's budget and I certainly didn't want it to stay there if we were not going to fund the Youth Academy. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Hefner. Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Mr. Speaker, I had indicated to Senator Nelson I would move for advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: We already have a motion to advance.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Okay. I am sorry, I didn't hear it.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any other discussion on the advancement of LB 21? Seeing none...Senator Hall. Senator Hall.
