PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Speaker Baack. I will recognize senators wishing to speak to this.

SPEAKER BAACK: I relinquish the rest of my time to Senator Hall, please.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Certainly. Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Madam President, I would ask Senator Baack and the members present for their authority to substitute, ask consent to substitute an amendment to the Baack amendment. There was a provision left out in Senator Baack's version that deals with December 31 on the...and it had to be moved, that date had to be moved to April 30. The rest of it coincides with the amendment that I have offered. But I just...there needed to be one technical change made and if there would be no objection, I would just like to ask that consent to substitute the amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hall. Senator Baack.

SPEAKER BAACK: I have no objection to that. If there is one thing that I missed, I have no objection to doing that. I would just withdraw mine and we can substitute the one from Senator Hall.

PRESIDENT MOUL: All right, thank you, Speaker Baack. If there are no objections, it's so ordered. Does anyone else wish to speak to this amendment? Seeing none, we will now vote on the Baack amendment to the Baack amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the Baack-Hall amendment to the Baack amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment to the amendment is adopted. Are there further motions, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further pending to Senator Baack's amendment, Madam President.
