PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Nelson. Senator Hall, followed by Senator Hefner. Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Madam President and members of the body, I have a question for Senator Baack, if he will...if he's around.

SENATOR HALL: May 1.

SENATOR HALL: Well, that would allow, Senator Hefner, five and a half months, from the time...from, in essence, the...

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay.

SENATOR HALL: ...effective date of this act.

SENATOR HEFNER: But we're right in the midst of a starter fertilizer season, the starter that you put on the corn plant...

SENATOR HALL: Okay.

SENATOR HEFNER: ...on May 1st.

SENATOR HALL: But it would be purchased prior to that, wouldn't it?

SENATOR HEFNER: Well, sometimes it is and sometimes it isn't. But...

SENATOR HALL: The minimum contracted for prior to that, wouldn't it?

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay. And I thought the Department of Revenue would like to cut off on an end of a quarter.

SENATOR HALL: Well, we could move it back to March 31, if you would like, but...
