Current law provides that if there is no ordinance adopting a plumbing code in effect for a city or village, the American National Standards Institute Uniform Plumbing Code, ANSI A40 1993, is to serve as the plumbing code for all area within the jurisdiction of the city or village. LB42 would change / update the referenced code to the 2009 Uniform Plumbing Code accredited by the American National Standards Institute. Similarly, current law provides that if there is no county resolution adopting a plumbing code in effect for a county, the American National Standards Institute Uniform Plumbing Code, ANSI A40 1993, is to apply. LB42 also changes / updates the referenced code for such counties to the 2009 Uniform Plumbing Code accredited by the American National Standards Institute. The change / update of the referenced plumbing code as provided in LB42 appears to represent no significant impact to affected political subdivisions.
