Revision: 00 FISCAL NOTE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL ANALYST ESTIMATE

*Does not include any impact on political subdivisions. See narrative for political subdivision estimates.

LB 239 changes provisions related to documentation required for voting.

Section 1 provides a definition for "Government-issued photographic identification".

The bill's provisions provide for utilization of "Government-issued photographic identification" for voting purposes.

Section 13 amends 60-4,115 so an applicant for a state identification card who indicates that he or she is indigent and in need of a state identification card for purposes of voting under the Election Act shall be issued a state identification card at no cost.

The Secretary of State estimates no fiscal impact.

The Department of Motor Vehicles estimates revenue loss due to the issuance of such identification cards at no cost for indigent individuals.

Any revenue loss should be negligible. One must assume that the indigent did not, in the past, obtain state identification cards. As indigent individuals, they would have been unable to pay the required fees. Since the fees would have been uncollected in the past, one is unable to say they will be lost in the future.

It requires the state ID card be issued at no cost if the applicant indicates that he or she is indigent. Without a clear definition of indigent, however, the number of ID cards that will issued at no cost cannot be determined. Over the past five years DMV has issued an average of 32,768 identification cards per year.
