LB 104 increases the current 34,000 pound maximum load for specified groups of axles to 36,000 pounds.

According to the Department of Roads, this action would put Nebraska out of compliance with federal vehicle weight limits on the Interstate highway system. The penalty for non-compliance is 10% of the federal National Highway System funds received by the state, which in Nebraska's case amounts to approximately \$8.5 million per year. The department indicates this loss of federal funding would cause a corresponding loss in highway construction expenditures.

\*The loss of federal reimbursement revenue will show up as a decrease in revenue to the Department of Roads Operations Cash Fund.

## **Explanation of Estimate:**

Date: 2/9/2011

LB 104 changes certain weight provisions for vehicles from 34,000 pounds to 36,000 pounds, including the interstate highway system.

This action would put Nebraska out of compliance with federal vehicle weight limitations on the interstate highway system. This would result in a penalty of 10% of the National Highway System (NHS) monies each year.

Nebraska receives approximately \$ 85 million of NHS monies per year. This 10% penalty would result in a loss of \$8.5 million per year. This loss of federal funds would cause a like reduction in highway construction work.

NOTE: Fiscal impact is shown all as cash funds as all expenditures for the Department of Roads are from the Roads Operations Cash Fund which is then reimbursed with federal funds.
