LB 281 amends the Nebraska Rules of the Road, Nebraska Revised Statutes Sections 53-186, 53-186.01, and 60-6,211.08 to provide an exception to having an open container of alcohol in a motor vehicle and consumption of an alcoholic beverage in a motor vehicle.

The bill provides a definition for limousine and specifies that passengers may possess open alcoholic beverage containers and consume alcoholic beverages while in a limousine or bus that is in a public parking area or on any highway in this state, as long as the driver of the vehicle is prohibited from consumption and the alcoholic liquor is not readily available to the driver and as long as the vehicle is being used in a charter or special party service as defined by the Public Service Commission.

Both the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission and the Nebraska State Patrol indicate no fiscal impact to the state.

We agree with both agencies estimate of fiscal impact.
