This bill has no fiscal impact for the Secretary of State, however:

Section 3 of the bill provides additional grounds for recording a certificate of change relating to a trademark or service mark registration. In 2011, the Secretary of State received 23 of these certificates. If an additional 23 certificates were received, the Secretary of State would receive increased revenue of \$115 annually. Section 5 of the bill provides for a filing to amend trade name registrations and sets forth a \$10 dollar filing fee. In 2011, the Secretary of State received 230 trade name assignments. If the Secretary of State were to receive 230 trade name amendments, the Secretary of State would receive increased revenue of \$2,300 annually. It is not anticipated that additional staff or programming would be necessary to accommodate the additional filings.
