LB 884 establishes a nine member Agriculture Literacy Task Force. The task force is to review state educational standards and curricula to determine if the standards and curricula provide a foundation for agriculture literacy. A report shall be provided to the Legislature on or before November 15, 2012. Staff of the Agriculture Committee of the Legislature shall provide administrative support for the task force. Members shall not receive compensation. The task force shall meet within 30 days after its members are appointed and the members must be appointed within 30 days after the effective date of the act. The act terminates on December 31, 2012.

The bill will have a general fund fiscal impact to reimburse task force members for actual expenses to attend task force meetings. It appears that up to five members of the task force may be eligible for the reimbursement of expenses. The cost to reimburse task force members per meeting is assumed to be \$1,000 (5 members x \$200 per meeting). The number of meetings is unknown. It is assumed the task force will meet at least once in FY2011-12 and three times in FY2012-13. If so, the estimated fiscal impact of the bill will be \$1,000 of general funds in FY2011-12 and \$3,000 in FY2012-13.

It is assumed that any staffing, administrative expenses and reimbursement of senator expenses associated with the task force can be handled with the existing staff and budgetary resources of the Legislative Council.
