LB 1003 doubles the minimum requirements for automobile liability insurance and uninsured and underinsured motor vehicle liability coverage from \$25,000 to \$50,000 for accidents involving one person. The bill also doubles the minimum coverage limits from \$50,000 to \$100,000 for accidents involving two or more persons. Proof of financial responsibility requirements are also increased accordingly. The operative date of the bill is January 1, 2013.

The Department of Administrative Services and the University of Nebraska indicate the bill has no fiscal impact in terms of the cost of motor vehicle liability coverage for state employees.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 1003 would increase the uninsured motor vehicle insurance limit from \$25,000 dollars to \$50,000 in any one accident for one person; would increase the uninsured motor vehicle limit from \$50,000 to \$100,000 in any one accident for two or more persons; and would increase the underinsured motor vehicle insurance limit for one person in an accident from \$25,000 to \$50,000 and for two or more persons in an accident from \$50,000 to \$100,000. LB 1003 also would increase automobile liability insurance from \$25,000 to \$50,000 for one person in any accident and increase for accidents involving two or more persons from \$50,000 to \$100,000. Limits for injury to or destruction of property of other persons in any one accident would be increased from \$25,000 to \$50,000 also by LB 1003. Proof of financial responsibility would reflect the new limits under the bill.

There would be no fiscal impact to DAS for increasing the limits from \$25,000 to \$50,000 per person or from \$50,000 to \$100,000 per accident regarding the different types of liability coverage in the bill.
