LB 1100 requires the appointment of an advisory committee by the chairperson of the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee of the Legislature to study unique health insurance and health care needs of Nebraska residents and employers and the most effective health insurance coverage models providing the most effective health care in terms of services and costs. A report is required by November 30, 2012.

The bill does not define the number of members of the advisory committee nor the number of meetings required for the group. The members of the advisory committee are eligible for the reimbursement of actual and necessary expenses for meetings per Section 81-1178.

It is assumed at least eight members will be appointed to the study committee and seven of the eight members will reside outside of Lincoln. Using an average cost of \$200 per meeting per individual outside of Lincoln and assuming three meetings of the study group, the general fund fiscal impact for the Legislative Council to reimburse committee member expenses is \$4,200 in FY2012-13. It is assumed the preparation of the report and staffing of the committee can be handled with the existing resources of the Legislative Council.
