Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 378 eliminates the additional \$5 fee charged for Pearl Harbor, prisoner of war, disabled veteran, and Purple Heart license plates. This \$5 fee is deposited in to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operations Fund for use in the operation of the Nebraska Veterans Cemetery located at Alliance.

The loss of revenue to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operations Fund is estimated to be \$14,000 annually based on previous fiscal year's actual revenue of \$15,492 in FY11 and \$14,775 in FY12. Since the bill does not have the emergency clause the revenue loss in FY14 is adjusted to reflect 10 months of impact.

The Appropriations Committee's preliminary recommendation uses the revenue from the veteran themed license plates deposited in to the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operations Fund to offset the need for General Funds to operate the veterans' cemetery. The current cash fund balance of \$66,708 (as of January 31, 2013) coupled with other cash fund revenue sources will be sufficient to fund the Committee's recommended appropriation of \$25,000 cash funds each year of the next biennium. However, at some point after that it will be necessary to increase the General Fund appropriation by an estimated \$14,000 per year to replace the lost cash fund revenue if the budget for the cemetery is to be maintained at the current level.
