Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB284 amends the Political Subdivisions Tort Claims Act as follows.

- 1. Increases the timeline to file a tort claim from one year to two years.
- 2. Increases the total amount recoverable per occurrence from
 - a. \$1 million to \$3 million for any person for any number of claims arising out of a single occurrence
 - b. \$3 million to \$12 million for all claims arising out of a single occurrence.

The City of Lincoln indicates that LB284 has the potential of significantly increasing costs to include insurance premiums (\$500,000 to \$700,000), higher negotiated settlements and an additional year in which to file claims. It would appear that similar costs could be realized by other political subdivisions.

Explanation of Estimate:

This bill has the potential to significantly increase annual insurance costs due to going from \$1M to \$3M. This will possibly increase premiums up to 3x for Lincoln, costing between \$500,000 to \$700,000 additional in stop loss premiums each year. It could also encourage higher negotiated settlements due to the higher potential court ordered settlements. An additional year to file claims also increases the potential cost by possibly having more claims. Paid claims have averaged \$658,000 over the last 10 years.
