LB 1111 would provide that on or before January 1, 2015, natural resources districts (NRDs) that adopted an integrated management plan (IMP) that explicitly stated an intent to use projects described under Section 2-3226.04 shall amend the IMP to include procedures to attain district-wide and basin-wide water sustainability by January 2025. It is estimated that there may be costs to the NRDs in order to meet the required sustainability provisions by January 2015. Costs would vary by NRD and would depend upon the details of the integrated management plan and anticipated projects.
