Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill changes provisions relating to motions for new trial based upon discovery of new evidence.

Currently, a motion for a new trial based on section 29-2101(5) cannot be filed more than 3 years after the verdict. This bill eliminates the 3 years restriction. Section 29-2101(5) reads "newly discovered evidence material for the defendant which he or she could not with reasonable diligence have discovered and produced at the trial".

It appears that this bill will not have a fiscal impact on the state or political subdivisions.
