Explanation of Estimate:

Under the proposed bill, revenues from the sale of truck plates would be discontinued. This represents a reduction of \$14,120 in annual revenues. The bill would establish a \$100 license fee which would increase existing revenues by \$5,520 annually. Thus, net revenues to the general fund would be reduced by \$8,600. These numbers are based on the total number of trucks and grain dealer licenses for the current year.
