Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB584 directs that \$16,290,000 be transferred from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Dental Clinic and Educational Facility Grant Fund which is newly created by the bill and is to be administered by the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education (CCPE). The specified transfer is to occur on or before July 1, 2016. For purposes of this fiscal note, the transfer is assumed to occur July 1, 2016 (FY2016-17). The transfer from the Cash Reserve Fund is reflected as a reduction to "Other Fund" revenue in the table above. Correspondingly, the transfer to the newly created grant fund is reflected as an increase in 2016-17 "Cash Fund" revenue in the above table.

The bill provides that the Dental Clinic and Educational Facility Grant Fund is to be used to provide a one-time grant for construction of a dental clinic and oral health training facility to serve the public health needs of Nebraska residents. Additionally, the bill identifies grant eligibility criteria and a grant application process. Specified grant eligibility criteria appear to require a grant applicant to identify matching funds from other sources on a four-to-one ratio with the grant from the Dental Clinic and Educational Facility Grant Fund. Other than an indication that these other sources may include private sources, they are not expressly identified and are therefore unknown and not specifically addressed in this fiscal note.

CCPE estimates that its administrative duties as assigned by LB584 would necessitate a .25 FTE grant administrator to develop a grant application, review applicant submissions, and monitor compliance with grant terms subsequent to award of a grant. The agency assumes the position would no longer be necessary upon final review of compliance with grant terms. It would appear that related costs could be met with amounts from the Dental Clinic and Educational Facility Grant Fund, i.e. from interest on the invested balance of the fund prior to its depletion through disbursement or disbursements from the fund for a related grant award. Given that the grant fund is to be used to provide a one-time grant for a construction project, grant disbursements may occur in installments over more than one fiscal year. Reliance on the grant fund to meet related administrative costs coupled with the timing of the directed transfer from the Cash Reserve Fund to the grant fund would impact the timing of the related grant application, award and administration processes.

LB584 creates a one-time grant program for the construction of a dental clinic and oral health training facility. The Commission would administer the fund. In order for an applicant to be considered eligible for this grant, the plan must include certain assurances such as providing \$4 of private money for every \$1 of state funding, educating at least 100 students annually, and providing charitable or discounted oral health care in at least five different counties throughout Nebraska.

In order to meet the administrative duties of the grant, the Commission believes that a monitoring program of the grant terms would be required. The Commission estimates a .25 FTE Grant Administrator would be necessary to write the grant application and review applicant submissions to insure the terms of the grant were met. Once the grant has been awarded, the Grant Administrator duties would transition to monitoring compliance with grant requirements, including those noted above. The Commission anticipates once the facility has been completed and final review of compliance with the grant terms are completed, this position would no longer be necessary.
