LB 201 changes the penalty for providing false information in the registration of a motor vehicle or trailer. The penalty is changed from a Class III misdemeanor to a Class IV felony.

It is possible there may be increased revenue from fines pursuant to the change in penalty. Revenue from fines accrues to the counties where the violation occurs and the revenue is used by public schools. No fiscal impact can be determined.

If sentences imposed for violations include incarcerations, there may be an increase in persons imprisoned by the Department of Correctional Services for a felony violation and a decrease in those jailed by counties for misdemeanors. A change in prison population pursuant the bill is projected to be minimal, if any.
