## LB 752 creates the Adult Career Pathways Task Force.

The purpose of the task force is to develop recommendations for connecting adult basic education programs to career pathways in high-demand occupations and connecting to work in the Department of Labor and the Department of Education's Division of Vocational Rehabilitation.

The task force is to consist of an executive committee composed of six members of the Legislature including the chairpersons of the Education, and the Business and Labor committees, the member is who is also a commissioner on the Midwest Higher Education Compact, and three other members appointed by the Executive Board of the Legislature. These members will comprise the executive committee and voting members of the task force.

The executive committee shall also appoint nonvoting members of the task force from representatives of adult basic education advocacy groups, educational institutions, the philanthropic community, local chambers of commerce, adult basic education service providers, and the business community. These appointed members shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses.

In addition, the Commissioner of Labor, Commissioner of Education, Director of the Department of Economic Development, Director of Correctional Services, and the executive director of the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education (or their designees), shall be nonvoting, ex officio members of the task force.

The Task Force is to:

- 1) Review and analyze student transition from adult basic education, English language learner, and general education development programs to career pathways;
- 2) Review and analyze adult basic education program currently administered by the State Department of Education, community colleges in Nebraska, and other adult basic education program providers;
- 3) Review and analyze high school equivalency in Nebraska;
- 4) Develop common performance definitions and measures that adult basic education programs, general educational development programs; and postsecondary educational institutions will use to track student progress;
- Analyze existing professional development opportunities for adult educators and develop a strategy for addressing any identified gaps related to connecting adult education learners to career pathways.

The Task Force may also appoint special committees to advise and assist the Task Force. Members of a special committee may not be reimbursed for their expenses for work done in relation to the special committee.

The Task Force is to submit a preliminary report by December 15, 2017 and a final report by December 15, 2018. The Task Force shall terminate December 31, 2018.

The bill is unclear as to where responsibility for staffing and expenses of the Task Force lie but, given the make-up of the executive committee of the Task Force composed entirely of members of the Legislature, we assume requests for reimbursement of expenses will be submitted to the Executive Board of the Legislature.

The Department of Labor has indicated no fiscal impact to the agency as a result of LB 752.

The Department of Education has indicated no fiscal impact to the department as a result of LB 752.

The Department of Economic Development indicated no fiscal impact to the department as a result of LB 752.

We agree with the agency's estimates of fiscal impact.

However, given our assumption that expense reimbursement requests will be made to the Executive Board of the Legislature, we estimate the following fiscal impact:

**Explanation of Estimate:** 

LB 752 creates the Adult Career Pathways Task Force. The Task Force will consist of 6 voting members and at least 5 nonvoting members, one of which is the Director of the Department of Economic Development (or her designee). Members will be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses.

The purpose of the Task Force is to develop recommendations for connecting adult basic education programs to career pathways in high-demand occupations and sectors. This will occur through (1) reviewing and analyzing student transition from adult basic education; (2) reviewing and analyzing adult basic education programs; (3) reviewing and analyzing high school equivalency in Nebraska; (4) developing performance definitions and measures to be used to track student progress; and (5) analyzing existing professional development opportunities for adult educators. The Task Force may appoint special committees to advise and assist the Task Force.

The Task Force shall submit a preliminary report on or before December 15, 2018 to the Governor and Legislature on recommendations resulting from the work of the Task Force. The Task Force terminates December 31, 2018.

LB 752 does not designate an agency to provide support to the Task Force. The Department of Economic Development's involvement appears to be limited to participation on the Task Force. However, the bill does not designate a required number of meetings. Based on the bill as drafted, the Department of Economic Development will have no costs associated with LB 752.
