The Division of Children and Family Services would end two contracts totaling \$883,800 with providers who seek and identify extended family members and supportive adults who are willing to provide lifelong supports and connections to children placed in out-of-home care.

The Division of Children and Family would assume all responsibilities of the family finding procees, this includes; the responsibility to identify family members, engage them in planning and decision making, gain their commitment to support the child and/or parents and achieve permanency or lifelong connections for the child.
