Explanation of Estimate: It is difficult to assess the fiscal impact on Lancaster County. Fewer depositions may be taken, which would save money, but the more likely result is that more cases may go to trial. Frequently, depositions of a key witness allow the attorneys to better assess their case. A prosecutor may realize their case is not as strong as they realized, causing them to dismiss the case or offer a plea bargain. If the witness is a strong witness for the State, the defense attorney may advise the client to accept an offer, and avoid the risk of trial. Denying depositions may have the unintended consequence of causing more alleged child victims to have to testify in open court at trial. More trials means more expense for the courts, the County Attorney, and the Public Defender.
