LB698 - TECHNICAL BILL: Pursuant to the Governor's direction NPERS completed a complete review of all chapters of Title 303, NAC, and the laws that provided the authority to promulgate those regulations. This bill modifies sections of the various retirement acts to make it optional for the PERB to promulgate rules and regulations when the PERB feels it is necessary, rather than requiring the PERB to promulgate rules and regulations even when the statute is clear.
