Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 1063 establishes additional fees for the issuance of: initial Class O operator's licenses; motorcycle endorsements; provisional operator's permits; learner's permits; and school permits. The fees are to be credited to a Brain Injury Cash Fund which is established by the bill.

The Brain Injury Cash Fund is to be administered through a contract with the University of Nebraska Medical Center. It is to be used to pay for contracts for assistance for victims of traumatic brain injury with outside sources that specialize in the area of traumatic brain injury. The funds may also be used for resource facilitation, training for service providers, follow-up contact and information on brain injuries for persons on the brain injury registry, activities to promote awareness of traumatic brain injury and prevention methods, research, quality improvement processes, and the collection of data and evaluation of how needs are being met. No more than 10% of the fund may be used by the University of Nebraska Medical Center to administer the fund. The bill is operative on January 1, 2019.

Revenue for the Brain Injury Cash Fund: The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) estimates the following amount of revenue will be received by the Brain Injury Cash Fund annually based upon 2017 licenses and permits issued. The cash fund revenue will be 50% of this amount in FY2018-19 due to the operative date of the bill.

Expenditures from Brain Injury Cash Fund: The bill specifies the activities that may be funded by the Brain Injury Cash Fund. No more than 10% may be expended each year by the University to administer the fund, so administrative costs will be no more than \$84,600 in FY19 and \$169,200 in FY20. The remainder of the funds will be used as aid for contracts to provide assistance to victims of traumatic brain injuries or other activities enumerated in the bill.

Expenditures by DMV Cash Fund: The DMV will incur one-time expenses of \$12,000 cash in FY2018-19 for computer programming to accommodate the increases in license and permit fees.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 1063 creates the Brain Injury Cash Fund from new fees collected on operators' licenses and state identification cards. The fund would be administered through a contract with the University of Nebraska Medical Center for administration, accounting, and budgeting purposes. The funds being used to pay for statewide contracts for assistance for victims of traumatic brain injury with outside sources that specialize in traumatic brain injury; work to secure and develop community-based services for victims of traumatic brain injury; provide support groups and access to pertinent information, medical resources, and service referrals; and educate professionals who work with victims of traumatic brain injury. Additionally, no more than ten percent of the fund shall be used for the administration of the fund. Our estimate is based on information from the Department of Motor Vehicles, who estimated approximately \$1.7M in new fees annually.
