Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 1122 would authorize the testing of automated motor vehicles as prescribed.

The bill creates the nineteen member Nebraska Council on Future Transportation that is tasked with developing recommendations for statewide policy changes to ensure that Nebraska is one of the leaders in autonomous, driverless, and connected motor vehicle technology. The recommended policy changes, and updates to such, are due no later than March 31, 2019, and at least annually thereafter. The bill states that council members are to serve without compensation and does not mention whether they would be eligible for expense reimbursement. The bill does require the Department of Transportation to provide staff support to the council.

Depending on the level of staff support requested by the Council there could be a need for the Department of Transportation to hire an additional employee or contract for support. At this time it is unknown what support will be requested so a definitive cost cannot be identified.
