LB 147 would make it a Class IV misdemeanor to violate subsection 1 of 60-6,304 regarding vehicles being constructed or loaded to prevent their contents from dropping, sifting, leaking or otherwise escaping from the vehicle. A misdemeanor of this class carries a fine of \$100 to \$500.

There should be no fiscal impact on expenditures. Any additional fine revenue collected due to the provisions of LB 147 will accrue to local schools.
