Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 398 pertains to the use of levy funds by learning communities. There is currently one learning community in Douglas/Sarpy counties. The learning community is authorized to levy up to \$.015 for early childhood education programs for children in poverty, for elementary learning centers employees, for contracted elementary learning center programs and services and for pilot projects. However, current law provides that no more than 10% of the funds raised from the \$.015 levy may be used for elementary learning center employees. The bill eliminates this limitation of the use of the tax proceeds.

The bill has no fiscal impact for the state. It may result in a change in how existing funds are spent by the learning community. The learning community indicates it could reduce expenditures for staff by hiring employees rather than contracting for staff. The savings are estimated to be about \$10,500 per year.
