This bill would prohibit sexual abuse of a detainee and change provisions relating to sexual abuse of an inmate or parolee.

The Supreme Court estimates a minimal fiscal impact from the provisions of this bill.

The Board of Parole estimates no significant impact from this bill.

The Nebraska State Patrol estimates no fiscal impact from this bill.

The Department of Correctional Services (DCS) states that the bill creates a new offense but that it is similar to an existing offense so it is unlikely to have much of an impact on the prison population. DCS notes that only one person was admitted for sexual abuse of an inmate or parolee between 2014 and 2018, and that person served 11 months before discharging. See the DCS response attached for additional details not included in this fiscal note.

Explanation of Estimate: Fiscal Impact in indeterminable.

Although the proposed language in LB 479 creates a new offense similar to the existing offense of sexual abuse of an inmate or parolee, it is unlikely to have an effect on the number of inmates admitted to, or the average daily population of, NDCS. Only one person was admitted to NDCS custody for sexual abuse of an inmate or parolee between 2014 and 2018, and that person served 11 months in custody before discharging from his sentence. While the effects of creating a new offense of sexual abuse of a detainee have the potential to increase the prison population, its effects are likely to be minimal, based on the number of individuals currently admitted to prison for similar offenses and the length of their incarceration.
