LB 165 would end Nebraska's participation in the Midwest Interstate Passenger Rail Compact. Annual dues have been \$15,000 and have been funded from the General Fund.

The compact includes the following language regarding a member states withdrawal, "Withdrawal from this compact shall be by enactment of a statute repealing the same and shall take effect one year after the effective date of such statute. A withdrawing state shall be liable for any obligations which it may have incurred prior to the effective date of withdrawal."

Based on this language, the fiscal impact would be a General Fund expenditure reduction of \$15,000 annually starting in FY2008-09.
