 regarding alcohol and drug levels found in the body fluid of an individual who dies or is injured as a result of a motor vehicle
 accident.
- A requirement that the Department of Transportation promulgate rules and regulations related to uniform standards for school bus loading area warning signs and refers school districts to a "manual" that will contain the requirements related to school bus loading areas.

The changes proposed in LB 190 have no fiscal impact.
