LB 136 would have no fiscal impact to state agencies.

LB 136 would adopt the Density Bonus and Inclusionary Housing Act. Cities of the metropolitan, primary and first classes would be required to comply with the act if an application for a density bonus for housing development is received. Cities would be allowed to adopt ordinances to specify how compliance with the Act would be implemented. Cities receiving applications for a density bonus would incur expenses to review applications, hold a public hearing, and monitor project compliance with the Act. Costs to cities would depend upon the number of applications for density bonuses and the complexity of projects.
