Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 343 is the School Safety Rapid Response Option Act. The bill allows schools to develop a program authorizing school employees who hold valid permits issued under the Concealed Handgun Permit Act to carry concealed handguns in or upon the school's building, grounds, vehicle, or school-sponsored activity or athletic event. Schools are defined to include any public, private, denominational or parochial elementary, vocational or secondary school, any private postsecondary career school or any postsecondary institution. The bill provides that the program developed by schools may require school employees to undergo additional training

The bill may have a fiscal impact for schools which opt to implement the act. There may be a workload increase and or additional expenses to adopt a policy and possibly provide training for employees who are authorized to carry concealed handguns on school property and at school events. The University of Nebraska indicates there may be liability issues in instances where a school district authorizes employees to carry concealed handguns and those employees are attending a school event hosted by the University if the University does not have a like policy.

As the bill currently reads, there is no clear legal guidance on this issue.
