LB 80 requires a county sheriff to establish a process to enter into an agreement with motor vehicle franchisee's to collect information for the identification inspection of motor vehicles which are in the inventory of the franchisee at a location in the county. The bill allows the inspection by the sheriff to be done electronically. The current fee required for the inspection is still provided by the franchisee.

Since the inspection fee is unchanged for the impacted motor vehicle dealers, the bill will not impact the revenue of counties. It may decrease the workload and or expenses of county sheriffs related to conducting on-site inspections.
