Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 544 is the Meadowlark Scholarship Act.

Section 2 provides definitions for the Act.

Section 3 creates the Meadowlark Scholarship Program, to be administered by the State Treasurer. Any qualified individual shall be eligible to participate in the program. The Department of Health and Human Services shall transmit information to the State Treasurer as necessary to administer the program and to establish whether the child is a qualified individual.

Section 4 creates the Meadowlark Scholarship Cash Fund. It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate to the fund an amount equal to one hundred dollars (per year) multiplied by the total number of children who began enrollment in the Meadowlark Scholarship Program during the prior fiscal year.

The Department of Health and Human Services estimates a one-time cost of \$7,500 to write and verify code related to the required transmittal of data to the State Treasurer. This estimate appears to be reasonable.

LB 544 is silent regarding the fund source that will be used for the \$100 state contribution to the Meadowlark Scholarship Program. In absence of an identified fund source, it is assumed that this will be a cost borne by the General Fund. Without knowing the number of enrollees per year, this amount cannot be determined.

The State Treasurer estimates no fiscal impact.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 544 creates a scholarship program that qualifies individuals based upon birth date and birth location among other conditions. LB 544 would require the Department of Health and Human Services to provide birth data within ninety days of birth to the State Treasurer's Office beginning January 1, 2020.

The Office of Vital Records would transmit the data reports electronically from the existing vital records system. The export would be set up to automatically execute and transmit a recurring report to the State Treasurer's Office. The Department estimates the vital records system vendor NetSmart would charge approximately \$7,500 to write and verify code to fulfill the requirements of LB 544.

LB 544 does not specify any source of funding for the Department's implementation costs. In the absence of authorization to invoice the State Treasurer for costs associated with LB 544, the Department assumes costs would be financed by the Vital Statistics Cash Fund (Program 262).
