Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 711 changes provisions related to convicted felons and restoration of voting rights. Under the provisions of LB 711, language requiring a convicted felon to wait two years before voting rights are restored is removed.

The Secretary of State estimates a cost of \$8,735 to modify the voter registration application and website. This estimate appears to be reasonable.

The Nebraska Department of Correctional Services estimates the need to hire 3.0 FTE to provide education to inmates about voting and meeting their rights.

LB 711 does not restore voting rights to convicted felons. The bill's provisions remove the *restoration* of voting rights without having to wait two years after the sentence is complete.

Article VI-2 of the Nebraska Constitution reads:

No person shall be qualified to vote who is non compos mentis, or who has been convicted of treason or felony under the laws of the state or of the United States, unless restored to civil rights.

The Constitutional prohibition of convicted felons' voting rights remains, unless otherwise restored.

Therefore, it appears that LB 711, by removing the restoration of voting rights, results in convicted felons not being allowed to vote even after the sentence is complete.

No fiscal impact.

## Explanation of Estimate:

LB 711 changes provision relating to voting qualifications for any persons convicted of a felony. This bill removes the language requiring any felon to wait two year to restore their voting rights.

There are currently two states that allow felons to vote while incarcerated, Maine and Vermont. NDCS estimates needing three FTE to provide education to inmates about voting and meeting their rights. These three FTE will travel to all ten facilities, they will provide information regarding registering to vote and requesting absentee ballots.
