Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB709 directs that the State Capitol Administrator (Office of the Nebraska Capitol Commission) is to provide for a place, other than a bathroom, that is shielded from view and free from intrusion by the public and has running water and electrical outlets, which may be used to express breast milk by any person authorized to be in the State Capitol.

The Office of the Capitol Commission (OCC) indicates that upon identification of available space in the Capitol that could meet the criteria specified in LB709, OCC would engage professional services to complete planning / bidding documents for the project. Subsequently, bids would be let to facilitate selection of a contractor to complete modification of the space for purposes identified in the bill. The OCC estimates total related project costs at \$50,000.

It would appear that project costs (particularly the construction cost component) may vary materially depending upon space identified to be available to meet the purpose of LB709. That is, construction costs to modify a space with readily available access to plumbing, electrical and/or heating/ventilating/air conditioning (HVAC) service would presumably be less than related costs to modify space for which current access to one or more of such services is not readily available.
