Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill would change funding provisions for the Community-based Juvenile Services Aid Program. It states that funding under the program shall only be available for services provided directly to juveniles or services provided to carry out express statutorily authorized functions. Any government entity applying for funds from the program shall develop policies governing the distribution of the funds that are adopted by the governing board of the entity after a public hearing.

At this time, the Crime Commission estimates no fiscal impact from this bill. The agency does note that if they are misinterpreting the bill they may need to submit a revised fiscal note at a later date.

The University of Nebraska estimates no fiscal impact from this bill.

Lancaster County estimates no fiscal impact from this bill.

Douglas County states that their 2019 pending Community-based Juvenile Services Aid grant proposes \$317,179, for non-direct services. Included in this amount is \$303,677 for the full or partial cost of the salaries and benefits for seven positions, plus \$13,502 for an expected one-time cost for a community-based provider for non-direct services to youth.

In their 2020 grant application, they anticipate similar ongoing non-direct service costs of \$312,786 for the full or partial cost of the salaries and benefits for seven positions, which amount includes a 3% salary increase. They do not anticipate any costs associated with a community-based provider. See their response attached for additional details.

Explanation of Estimate: LB 651 makes changes to the requirements for a subgrantee to qualify for an award under the Community Bases Juvenile Services program .. i.e. "funding under the program shall only be available for services directly to juveniles or services provided to carry out express statutorily authorized functions". Our agency administers those funds and the new requirements would necessitate changing our application document and change our process for evaluating applications to ensure they meet the language in LB 651.

The bill also requires any government entity applying for funds from the program to develop policies governing the distribution of the funds that are adopted by the governing board after a public hearing. There is no requirement for the Crime Commission to review or approve these policies. It appears there is no fiscal impact on our agency from LB 651, but if we are misinterpreting the impact we may need to submit a revised fiscal note at a later date.

Douglas County's pending application for the 2019 Community-based Juvenile Services Aid grant allocation proposes approximately \$317,179 for non-direct services, including primarily full and partial funding support for salary and benefits of seven positions.

Douglas County's application also proposes (likely one-time) contracted services by a community-based provider of non-direct services to youth. Douglas County's 2020 Community-based Juvenile Services Aid grant application has not been developed but anticipates similar ongoing non-direct service costs, reflecting an additional 3% salary increase for positions.
